There is a highly likelyhood that the OPR will be further reviewed and reduced in the next few months. Hopefully these steps will generate more liquidity in the market and boost buying and the economy!

The event involved groups being formed to wage a battle against each other in an obstacle filled environment, and the group with the most points win after several rounds of playing against each other. Most of the staff enjoyed themselves tremendously and I understand that after running around so much, they were so hungry that there wasn't enough food and KK Lau had to order more food!

The end of the year approaches and with the challenging times, we will need to tighten our belts and yet rush towards our year end KPIs. I hope everyone continues to work hard and think of ways to be more productive, as we will need every one to play their part to achieve the Group's target!

At the project sites, our EPCC project for the RAPID Water Treatment Plant in Pengerang Johor recently achieved a Safety award for 1.0million Manhours without LTI. A ceremony was jointly held together with Petronas, Petronas PMC and us to celebrate this event. As mentioned by one of Petronas Directors during the celebration: safety is a key criteria for working with Petronas as Petronas is a world class organisation, and any organisation that can work well with Petronas will be world class! I would like to congratulate the LLWT Team for this achievement as this project is extremely fast track and has required a lot of effort under very stringent conditions.
